THE MARINA



We are located on the eastern side of the River Dart in the stunning South Hams countryside surrounded by glorious rolling hills and opposite the historic and famous town of Dartmouth.

MARINA FACILITIES



WI-FI - is available both on the main Marina and visitors' pontoon. Visitors can obtain the guest access code from the Berthing Office upon payment of the visiting fee. To access Wi-Fi select the Darthaven Club Wi-Fi hotspot. Extra time can be purchased through the portal. If you have any problems with this service please call Club Wi-Fi on 01626 270140.



Gas & Bottles - a range of Calor Gas and Camping Gaz refill exchanges and new cylinders can be purchased from the Berthing Office.



Launderette - situated at the back of our facilities block, with two industrial washing machines and tumble dryers. A sink and ironing board are also provided. Both the washers and dryers are coin operated and can be accessed from 08:30-23:00 during the summer or 08:30-22:00 in winter (£4 per wash, 20p per five minute drying cycle).



Car Park - over 230 car parking spaces are available for use by berth holders, visitors and general public. The car park operates a Pay & Display system with a Number Plate Recognition system, run by Premier Parking Solutions (PPS). Annual or 6 month permits can be arranged directly with PPS - 0845 8621034 - NOT through Darthaven.



Waste & Recycling - located opposite our Berthing and Service Office is the waste disposal area. We recycle as much waste product as possible and would greatly appreciate if, during your stay, you could do the same.

- Separated into two sections, general waste on the left and recycling on the right, it's never been
 easier. Please separate your glass waste.
- For the disposal of waste oil, please find the large green tank located under the railway bridge as
 marked on the Marina Map (page 9). For used fuel and oil filters please use the allocated bins to
 the right of the Engineering Workshop.



Pyrotechnic Disposal - in our Chandlery, we accept out of date flares only when purchasing replacements, so be sure to ask a member of our staff for more information.

Otherwise, a licensed contractor must dispose of all waste flares. FIRE HAZARD! - DO NOT DISPOSE OF FLARES IN THE RECYCLING BINS



Security - CCTV operates 24 hours a day and monitored by our night staff on duty daily (7 days/week).

- Access to the Marina can only be gained by entrance though our electronic gates operated using an
 access code.
- Visitors should ask for the entrance code at the Berthing Office. This system is also in place in order to gain access to our facilities block and washroom areas.
- We operate a barrier entrance to the boatyard.

ON THE PONTOON

Darthaven Marina has 270 berths in total set over four main pontoons. We pride ourselves on keeping a clean and well-maintained environment throughout the year. **Water and electricity** outlets are available in every location and berth, along with well-lit walkways making for safe use during the evenings and at night. 16amp & 32amp electricity is available (32amp with selected berths only).

Berth holders are reminded to ensure their **mooring** lines are suitable for winter storms etc – if unable to get down to your boat or nervous about your boat's security over the winter, please give the Berthing Office a call and they will be happy to check on your behalf.

It's a good idea for berth holders to leave **boat keys** with the Berthing Office . . . just in case a problem arises in a boat owner's absence.



BERTHING & SERVICE OFFICES

At the top of the main bridge situated on the left is our **Berthing Office** – the Marina Manager, Martin Pragnell and his team are located in the office to assist all visiting boats and berth holders.

Located on the right is our **Service Office** run by Chris Bickle, Robin Coomer and Katie Leedham. They are your first point of contact to organising works by any service department within Darthaven.

THE BERTHING OFFICE IS OPEN FROM 8.30AM TO 00.00 MIDNIGHT FROM MARCH TO OCTOBER AND 8.30AM TO 10.00PM FROM NOVEMBER TO FEBRUARY.

MARINA SAFETY

FOR YOUR SAFETY, DARTHAVEN MARINA EXPECTS...

- The wearing of lifejackets/buoyancy aids by all children under 14 years old when on the pontoons or aboard boats in the marina.
- Walk, don't run along the pontoons and do use the handrail on the access gangway.
- Cycles and scooters should only be ridden on the public road and not on the pontoons, the quay or any other part of the marina premises.
- For the benefit of all berth holders, dogs must be on a lead when on the quay, the pontoons, the car park indeed anywhere on the marina site. And do, please, ensure that no fouling occurs.
- Signs on the standpipes indicate that Darthaven Marina recommends that water be boiled before drinking when acquired through hoses.
- To avoid being a hazard to berth holders, trolleys should be returned to the area near the marina office after use. Do not overload them and no children in them at any time, please.
- No part of a boat, including its anchor, should overhang the walkways or pontoons.
- No items should be left on the pontoons or walkways at any time. This includes commercial fish boxes and diving bottles.
- If you have a fire on board, from your cockpit determine a sensible course of action . . . call the Fire service (999) . . . activate the fire alarm (by the Berthing Office) if practical. Maintain awareness if fire occurs anywhere in marina . .
- Take instructions from staff and/or emergency services.

BERTHING AND STORAGE

SUMMER BERTHING

During the Summer months, a small number of annual berth holders visit various parts of the UK or Channel Islands for extended periods of time. Due to this, berths of all sizes can become available between April and September. Contact a member of the Berthing Office staff for details.

WINTER BERTHING

Darthaven is the perfect safe and secure environment to winter your boat. Due to the Marina's position, we are very sheltered even during the worst of weather. Bring your boat in from a swinging mooring, anchorage or trot for convenient 24hr access and onsite parking.

Water is included and electricity charged at a unit rate. Winter berths are available from the 1st October to 31st March

Visitors are always advised to call ahead, ensuring one of the Berthing team is aware of your planned arrival

Due to high demand, we are unable to reserve berths in advance during the Summer months but will always do our utmost to accommodate vessels of all sizes up to 20m (65ft). Payment is due upon arrival.

Visiting yachts are requested to vacate the berth by 12:00 midday on the intended day of departure.

Around Dartmouth

Dartmouth Castle

Impossible to miss, Dartmouth Castle provides the focal point for many postcard shots of the Dart Estuary. Dating from 1488, it once protected the town from potential naval attack by a combination of a chain slung across the river mouth and a formidable collection of artillery. The castle and **St Petrox Church** are a must-see for anyone visiting the town. They can be accessed either by taking a short walk/drive from the Harbour Office or by the Castle ferry from Dartmouth Quay (opposite Rockfish). Also a Café with spectacular views across the Castle.

Britannia Royal Naval College

With an intriguing heritage spanning over 150 years, the BRNC is an essential place to visit for anyone with an interest in British history. Since 1863, Dartmouth and the River Dart have been the home of initial Naval Officer training in the UK – today, the BRNC is the only remaining Naval College in the country, fulfilling a vital role in training Naval cadets not only from Britain but those from the Commonwealth and all over the world.

Along the coast

The Daymark

An 80ft octagonal limestone tower built in 1864 as a guide to mariners to the position of the harbour entrance. It is visible for many miles out to sea and is a true wonder of the South Devon coastline! Access via the South West Coastal Path from Froward Point, or park at Brownstone Car Park near Coleton Fishacre.

Blackpool Sands

Hallsands

Discover the haunting remains of the lost village of Hallsands, between Beesands and Start Point. Sited at the end of the headland on one of the most exposed peninsulas of the English Coast,





Directions

- 1. From Darthaven Marina, turn right out of the car park along the road, then bear right again towards Lower Ferry.
- 2. At Kingswear Village Hall, turn left up Church Hill (The Ship Inn & St Thomas Church opposite). At top of hill, at hairpin bend, turn right along Castle Road (not Beacon Lane).
- **3**. After 0.5 mile, turn right down wooden steps, signposted Froward Point 1½ m.
- **4**. Just past Mill Bay Cove, turn right onto private drive, and then left after 30m, up steps and through woods. Pass above Newfoundland Cove to Brownstone Battery. (To explore the Battery, drop down the path to the right by the Coastwatch station. Turn left by the first searchlight post, then left again following the 'acorn' waymarker. Fork left once more to wind back up to the Coastwatch lookout).

- **5**. Bear left onto the track signed 'HG Brownstone'. Past the Day Mark, fork left onto a green lane signed for Kingswear.
- 6. Turn left at Brownstone and follow the footpath through the farm and past Crocker's Cottage crossing a small stream on large stones (taking care as, may be slippery). The footpath joins a private road. Bear left where the road forks, and then left again.
- 7. Follow Castle Road to Church Hill. Turn left down Alma Steps. Retrace your steps past the steam railway, and fork left past the bus shelter to the car park.

Kingswear to Greenway

One of the area's truly great walks, this daylong ramble follows the wooded banks of the broad and beautiful river Dart, on a route crammed with gems and jewels of human and natural history.

Start: Darthaven Marina Car Park Distance: 9 miles (circular walk) Grade: Moderate to strenuous

Terrain: Footpaths, fairly even, occasionally muddy through fields in wet weather; surfaced roads.

Obstacles & Steep Gradients: 10 stiles (3 can be bypassed); 3 flights of steps; 4 steep ascents; 2 steep descents. This route is not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs.

OS map: Explorer 0L20. Grid Ref: SX 878515 Directions

1. From Darthaven Marina, by the railway level crossing follow yellow - marked footpath along-side railway line. Head North with the river on your left.

- 2. At the Higher Ferry slipway, turn right over the level crossing and up road. Just beyond public toilets, bear right up ramp and steps to climb through woods.
- **3**. At tarmac road at top, turn left along drive, signed 'Greenway Ferry and Maypool'.
- 4. At main road take footpath opposite and to left down steps and through woods. Take care crossing this road as ferry traffic turns at this sharp bend with limited visbility. At the tarmac drive take footpath opposite and to right, leading into Long Wood.
- **4**. At t- junction in woods, turn left and follow track through woods above river. Track eventually curves to right and uphill. Turn left along terrace path.
- **5**. After steep climb, turn left over stile and follow path. Part way down hill, cross into field to right over stile and continue down along hedge line.
- **6**. At field exit turn left, signed 'Greenway Gardens ¾m'. Pass through gate and down track past houses. Turn left at road.
- **7**. Continue along road and through gate. By Greenway Estate information panel turn right

LOCAL WALKS & TRAILS (CONTINUED)

through gate. Once over brow of hill bear left down field edge path. At the bottom turn right along Greenway Drive.

- **8**. By the lodge house turn left down road to quay. Cross river via ferry. Alternatively, retrace your steps to the Marina. There is a Café at Greenway House but entrance charges may apply
- **9**. Walk up road through Dittisham. After 350m, turn sharp left along Rectory Lane.
- 10. Turn right after 250m up track along public

footpath. After a further 100m, turn left over stile and follow path up along field edges.

- 11. Turn left at the road. (Alternative easier route from here: continue along road past Bozomzeal then turn right and follow waymarkers through fields and round edge of wood. Turn left down green lane to rejoin main route at the bottom).
- **12**. Main route: After 250m, turn left, signed 'Permissive Path Old Mill Creek'. Follow well-used track initially then follow waymarkers along field edges.
 - **13.** Where path meets green lane, turn left. After 200m, turn right down path which leads towards river. After crossing a stile cut diagonally down across next field, and through woods.
 - **14**. At bottom of steps bear left, and then left again where you ioin a further track.
 - **15**. At Old Mill Creek cross over bridge and follow road up out of valley.
 - **16**. At t- junction in Townstal, turn right along Archway Drive and then first left onto Townstal Crescent.
 - 17. Cross main road at pedestrian crossing and turn left down hill. Turn first right along Church Rd and down hill.
 - **18**. Cross at next junction down Mount Boone. Fork right down Townstal Hill. At Vicarage Hill turn left down the narrow lane.
 - 19. Turn right down steps of Brown's Hill and bear left. At the bottom, head towards the church tower. When you meet the road turn left. Cross into Royal Avenue Gardens and onto South Embankment. Just past Station Restaurant turn left onto pontoon. Take passenger ferry to Kingswear.

MAYFLOWER 400

In 1620, the Mayflower and the Speedwell set sail from Southampton for the New World with Pilgrims, passengers and crew onboard, but they were forced to put into Dartmouth to repair the leaking Speedwell. The ship was "thorowly searcht from steme to steme [and] some leaks were found & mended"; and then they waited several days for a fair wind. When they set sail again the Speedwell continued to leak, so they returned to Plymouth. "No spetiall leake could be founde", but the Speedwell was abandoned, and the Mayflower set off alone. According to William Bradford's account, the Speedwell's master and crew "plotted this strategem to free themselves".

During 2020, in common with 11 other destinations throughout the UK, Netherlands and the US, Dartmouth will be commemorating 400 years since the Pilgrims set sail for America, and the part our town played in that story. A major programme of activities are planned during 2020, including arts and culture events, educational projects and the opening of a Heritage Trail through the town.

The maritime focus of these events will be **Mayflower Week** – 29 August to 5 September 2020 – there will be a variety of activities on the river, between Totnes and the Harbour mouth, including fun races and ship visits.

The week will start on 29 August with a "day sail" for local disabled and disadvantaged young people in SV Tenacious, followed on 30 Aug by a Grand River Pageant involving local and visiting craft of all types,

led by Matthew of Bristol and Pilgrim of Brixham representing Mayflower and Speedwell respectively.

MAYFLOWER HERITAGE TRAIL

Dartmouth's Mayflower Heritage Trail tells a local story, and its relationship with the wider voyage undertaken by the Pilgrims. It paints a picture of 17th century Dartmouth, as it was when the Pilgrims sailed into the harbour in 1620. Dartmouth's Trail is linked to the National Mayflower Trail that charts the story of the Pilgrims from their birthplaces to their settlement in the New World. You can download the Mayflower Self-Guided Tours app (www.mayflower400uk.org/ app), an innovative and informative free app that provides users with free, easy to follow self-guided tours of the UK towns, cities and villages connected to the Mayflower, including the Dartmouth Town Trail.



Dartmouth's Town Trail is marked by a series of wonderful bronze markers, created by Tom Leaper, a South West artist. Look out for these around town together with information boards such as one at Bayards Cove. A free Trail Map leaflet is also available detailing the location and history of each point of interest. Copies are available from the Dartmouth Visitor Centre and other pick up points in the town.

Dart Music Festival - May 15, 16 & 17

With more than 100 performers spread across 20 venues over three days the Dart Music Festival attracts artists and audiences from across the country. 
