WELCOME



As CEO I would like to welcome all our berth holders, service customers and visiting boat owners to our marina during 2024.

As we approach 50 vears since

my family took over the railway siding, coaling wharf and Royal Dart building we have come a long way. On site we have 270 berths, a visitors/ works pontoon along with a chandlery and a 40 tonne travel hoist. We also have a service team of qualified marine engineers, electronic/ electrical engineers and boat repairers for GRP and wooden boats. This enables us to offer a one stop shop for all marine services to our berth holders and local customers.

We continue to develop our facilities to provide the best service we can in a comparatively small area. Over the last two years we have built a new marina/service office on the quay. We are in the process of a total refurbishment of our shower block and foyer for opening at the beginning of May. The rolling programme of pontoon renewal and maintenance means they are kept up to a high and safe standard. The rest of the site has also been improved with an area of the carpark concreted and the boundary fence replaced plus other tidying up jobs.

The major development for Darthaven Services is the purchase of the trade and assets of Marine Engineering Looe based at Queen Anne's Battery, Plymouth. This will enhance our position as Volvo Penta's main direct dealer in the southwest. We will also be supplying parts and supporting four other indirect dealers. We have employed two of their engineers and two parts staff. We intend to employ two more engineers, one for Kingswear and one for Plymouth so we can deliver on increasing demand.

I am very hopeful we have sold the last of the units in the Royal Dart building on the quay by the passenger ferry. We can then set up a management company to take over the freehold and running costs of the whole building.

Since Covid the village has come back to life. There is a thriving village shop, a café, two pubs, a small wine bar, a coffee shop, a post office, an estate agent and the Royal Dart Yacht Club where visiting boat owners are welcome. The village offers most of what visiting boats owners would need. We also have a seasonal catering unit on site offering coffee and a range of snacks. It is easy to get across to Dartmouth either by dinghy or on one the ferries leaving from the quay. The town has plenty to offer including a wide range of pubs, cafés and restaurants. There is an M&S Simply Food store as well as a Co-op supermarket along with a range of other shops in the lower part of the town and a Sainsbury's and Lidl at the top of the town.

You'll find plenty of walks in the area around Kingswear and Dartmouth. Maps showing walks that start from the marina are printed in this Yearbook and more are available from the Kingswear Post Office. I recommend a trip up the beautiful river either in your dinghy or on one of the ferries from Dartmouth's Town Quay. There is lots to see with an abundance of wild life. There are also two National Trust properties nearby at Coleton Fishacre and Greenway and taking the steam train to Paignton from adjacent to the marina is a must do! There is plenty to see or do locally in this beautiful environment.

We are pleased to say demand for our permanent berths and services is proving very resilient. Our thanks goes out to all our loyal customers. With our ongoing investment in both our staff and the site, I believe we can continue to offer a professional service in the present difficult economic environment.

After the very wet and windy winter and early spring let's hope we can all enjoy a warm and pleasant boating season.



MARINA FACILITIES



WI-FI - is available both on the main Marina and visitors' pontoon. Visitors can obtain the guest access code from the Berthing Office upon payment of the visiting fee. To access Wi-Fi select the Darthaven Club Wi-Fi hotspot. Extra time can be purchased through the portal. If you have any problems with this service please call Club Wi-Fi on 01626 270140.



Gas & Bottles - a range of FloGas and Camping Gaz refill exchanges and new cylinders can be purchased from the Berthing Office.



Launderette - situated at the back of our facilities block, with two industrial washing machines and tumble dryers. A sink and ironing board are also provided. Both the washers and dryers are coin operated and can be accessed from 08:30 - 22:00. (£4 per wash, 20p per five minute drying cycle).



Car Park - over 230 car parking spaces are available for use by berth holders, visitors and general public. The car park operates a Pay & Display system with a Number Plate Recognition system, run by Premier Parking Solutions (PPS). Annual or 6 month permits can be arranged directly with PPS - 0845 8621034 - NOT through Darthaven.



Electric Vehicles - there are 4 EV car charging units for electric vehicles, immediately south of the main building. Please download the app **Charge Assist** if you wish to use the chargers.



Waste & Recycling - located opposite our Berthing and Service Office is the waste disposal area. We recycle as much waste product as possible and would greatly appreciate if, during your stay, you could do the same.

For the disposal of waste oil, please find the large green tank located under the railway bridge as
marked on the Marina Map (page 9). For used fuel and oil filters please use the allocated bins to the
right of the Engineering Workshop.



Pyrotechnic Disposal - in our Chandlery, we accept out of date flares only when purchasing replacements, so be sure to ask a member of our staff for more information. A small fee will apply per flare. Otherwise, a licensed contractor must dispose of all waste flares. **FIRE**HAZARD! - DO NOT DISPOSE OF FLARES IN THE RECYCLING BINS OR ANY OTHER WASTERIN



Security - CCTV operates 24 hours a day and monitored by our night staff on duty daily (7 days/week).

- Access to the Marina can only be gained by entrance through our electronic gates operated using an
 access code.
- Visitors should ask for the entrance code at the Berthing Office. This system is also in place in order to gain access to our facilities block and washroom areas.
- We operate a barrier entrance to the boatyard.

ON THE PONTOON

Darthaven Marina has 270 berths in total set over four main pontoons. We pride ourselves on keeping a clean and well- maintained environment throughout the year. **Water and electricity** outlets are available in every location and berth, along with well-lit walkways making for safe use during the evenings and at night. 16amp & 32amp electricity is available (32amp with selected berths only).

Berth holders are reminded to ensure their **mooring** lines are suitable for winter storms etc – if unable to get down to your boat or nervous about your boat's security over the winter, please give the Berthing Office a call and they will be happy to check on your behalf. It's a good idea for berth holders to leave **boat keys** with the Berthing Office . . . just in case a problem arises in a boat owner's absence.

MARINA SAFETY

FOR YOUR SAFETY, DARTHAVEN MARINA EXPECTS...

- The wearing of lifejackets/buoyancy aids by all children under 14 years old when on the pontoons or aboard boats in the marina.
- Walk, don't run along the pontoons and do use the handrail on the access gangway.
- Cycles and scooters should only be ridden on the public road and not on the pontoons, the quay or any other part of the marina premises.
- For the benefit of all berth holders, dogs must be on a lead when on the quay, the pontoons, the car park indeed anywhere on the marina site. And do, please, ensure that no fouling occurs.
- Signs on the standpipes indicate that Darthaven Marina recommends that water be boiled before drinking when acquired through hoses.

- To avoid being a hazard to berth holders, trolleys should be returned to the area near the marina office after use. Do not overload them

 and no children in them at any time, please.
- No part of a boat, including its anchor, should overhang the walkways or pontoons.
- No items should be left on the pontoons or walkways at any time. This includes commercial fish boxes and diving bottles.
- If you have a fire on board, from your cockpit determine a sensible course of action . . . call the Fire service (999) . . . activate the fire alarm (by the Berthing Office) if practical. Maintain awareness if fire occurs anywhere in marina.
- Take instructions from staff and/or emergency services.

BERTHING AND STORAGE

SUMMER BERTHING

During the Summer months, a small number of annual berth holders visit various parts of the UK or Channel Islands for extended periods of time. Due to this, berths of all sizes can become available between April and September. Contact a member of the Berthing Office staff for details.

WINTER BERTHING

Darthaven is the perfect safe and secure environment to winter your boat. Due to the Marina's position, we are very sheltered even during the worst of weather. Bring your boat in from a swinging mooring, anchorage or trot for convenient 24hr access and onsite parking.

Water is included and electricity is charged through our online system Berth Master, which our berthing team will help you set up on arrival. Winter berths are available from the beginning of October to the end of February. Stay afloat on our sheltered and safe marina, subject to availability.

The use of our on-site facilities are also available for use during your time here at Darthaven. Access to the facilities can be gained through the Berthing Office.



VISITING YACHTS

Visitor berths are available all year round and are located next to the main Marina. Arranged in the shape of an H, this pontoon can accommodate up to 12 to 24 boats rafted during the busiest periods. Visitors are always advised to call ahead, ensuring one of the Berthing team is aware of your planned arrival.

Due to high demand, we are unable to reserve berths in advance during the Summer months but will always do our utmost to accommodate vessels of all sizes up to 20m (65ft). Payment is due upon arrival

Visiting yachts are requested to vacate the berth by 12:00 midday on the intended day of departure.

CASE STUDY - BELLA MARIA

Annual maintenance



1. Hull Polish The hull was acid washed (natural and safe acid); this helps remove deep staining and old polishes/waxes and contaminates. The antifoul was taped up to prevent dragging the paint into the polish and any other delicate areas were taped. We then rotary machine cut and polished the hull. A polymer wax was then applied and buffed off leaving a high gloss finish. Brand new polishing pads are used on every boat.

2. Rubbing Strake Polish The gelcoat was acid washed (natural and safe acid) and areas protected. We then machine rotary compound/cut the gelcoat to remove any fading and oxidisation. A machine orbital polisher was then used with a high gloss polish to remove cut marks, leaving a high gloss finish. A hand applied polymer wax was applied to all polished areas.





4. Thruster Blade Removal, Refit
Anodes Removal: The blades were removed, sanded, degreased and then coated with primer and three coats of Hempel Eco Prop in black. Refit: This was greased and refitted along with new nylock nuts and washers. Anodes: Ttwo

thread lock was used (blue).







5. Bathing Platform Antifoul Application & Anodes Prop acid was applied to the metal work. This was then thoroughly rinsed before the area was machine cleaned with a wire wheel. The mechanism was machine and hand etched with P80 sandpaper, all delicate areas were taped. One even coat of Hempel Underwater primer was applied and left to cure. Two thick and even coats of International Trilux 33 were then applied.

6. Trim Tab Antifoul
Application & Anodes The trim tabs were machine cleaned with a wire wheel to remove all of the marine growth/build up. These were then etched with P80 sandpaper. One even coat of Hempel Underwater primer was applied and left to cure. Two thick and even coats of International Trilux 33 were then



7. Bathing Mechanism Anodes Six new Technoseal disc mechanism anodes were fitted with new nylock nuts and washers.

Annual maintenance

HULL POLISH

The hull was acid washed (natural and safe acid) this helps remove deep staining and old polishes/waxes. The antifoul was taped up to prevent dragging the paint into the polish and any other delicate areas were taped. We then rotary machine cut and polished the hull.

A polymer wax was then applied and buffed off leaving and high gloss, swirl and hologram free shine. Brand new polishing pads are used on every boat.





ANTI-FOUL PREPARATION & APPLICATION

Preparation: The entire hull was hand etched with P80 sandpaper and an underwater primer was applied in any necessary areas. Application: One thick and even coat of Hempel Tiger Extra (Teccel edition) was applied. A second coat was applied to high friction areas including the keel and rudders.





SUPERSTRUCTURE POLISH

The gelcoat was acid washed (natural and safe acid) and areas protected. We then machine rotary compound/cut the gelcoat to remove any fading and oxidisation. A machine orbital polisher was then used with a high gloss polish to remove cut marks, holograms and swirls, leaving a perfect fin-

ish. A hand applied polymer wax was applied to all polished areas and a double coat of wax on the coach roof and high UV areas.

SAIL DRIVE ANITFOUL PREPARATION & APPLICATION

Three thick and even coats of Hempel Eco prop in grey was applied to the sail drive.





BOW THRUSTER REMOVAL, REFIT & ANODES

The blades were removed, sanded, degreased and then coated with three coats of Hempel Eco Prop in Black. They were then



greased and refitted along with new nylock nuts and washers. A new anode was fitted. Medium strength thread lock was used (blue).

Around Dartmouth

Dartmouth Castle

Impossible to miss, Dartmouth Castle provides the focal point for many postcard shots of the Dart Estuary. Dating from 1488, it once protected the town from potential naval attack by a combination of a chain slung across the river mouth and a formidable collection of artillery. The castle and **St Petrox Church** are a must-see for anyone visiting the town. They can be accessed either by taking a short walk/drive from the Harbour Office or by the Castle ferry from Dartmouth Quay (opposite Rockfish). Also a Café with spectacular views across the Castle.

Britannia Royal Naval College

With an intriguing heritage spanning over 150 years, the BRNC is an essential place to visit for anyone with an interest in British history. Since 1863, Dartmouth and the River Dart have been the home of initial Naval Officer training in the UK – today, the BRNC is the only remaining Naval College in the country, fulfilling a vital role in training Naval cadets not only from Britain but those from the Commonwealth and all over the world.

The Engine House (adjacent to the Dartmouth Visitor Centre) is home to the only original Newcomen engine that can be shown working. 

In the 30 acre garden, it is easy to imagine the parties of the past amongst the weaving pathways and sheltered glades. 
- 1. From Darthaven Marina, turn right out of the car park along the road, then bear right again towards Lower Ferry.
- 2. At Kingswear Village Hall, turn left up Church Hill (The Ship Inn & St Thomas Church opposite). At top of hill, at hairpin bend, turn right along Castle Road (not Beacon Lane).
- **3**. After 0.5 mile, turn right down wooden steps, signposted Froward Point 1½ m.
- **4**. Just past Mill Bay Cove, turn right onto private drive, and then left after 30m, up steps and through woods. Pass above Newfoundland Cove to Brownstone Battery. (To explore the Battery, drop down the path to the right by

the Coastwatch station. Turn left by the first searchlight post, then left again following the 'acorn' waymarker. Fork left once more to wind back up to the Coastwatch lookout).

- **5**. Bear left onto the track signed 'HG Brownstone'. Past the Day Mark, fork left onto a green lane signed for Kingswear.
- **6**. Turn left at Brownstone and follow the footpath through the farm and past Crocker's Cottage crossing a small stream on large stones (taking care as, may be slippery). The footpath joins a private road. Bear left where the road forks, and then left again.
- **7**. Follow Castle Road to Church Hill. Turn left down Alma Steps. Retrace your steps past the steam railway, and fork left past the bus shelter to the car park.







Kingswear to Greenway

One of the area's truly great walks, this ramble follows the wooded banks of the broad and beautiful river Dart, on a route crammed with gems and jewels of human and natural history.

Start: Darthaven Marina Car Park

Distance: 4.5 miles Grade: Moderate

Terrain: Footpaths, fairly even, occasionally muddy through fields in wet weather; surfaced roads.


Obstacles & Steep Gradients: 5 stiles; 2 flights of steps; 2 steep climbs. This route is not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs.

OS map: Explorer 0L20. Grid Ref: SX 878515

Directions

- 1. From Darthaven Marina, by the railway level crossing follow yellow marked footpath alongside railway line. Head North with the river on your left.
- **2**. At the Higher Ferry slipway, turn right over the level crossing and up road. Just beyond public toilets, bear right up ramp and steps to climb through woods.
- **3**. At t- junction, turn left along drive, signed 'Greenway Ferry and Maypool'. Then at main road take footpath opposite and to left down steps and through woods. Take care crossing this road as ferry traffic turns at this sharp bend with limited visbility. At the tarmac drive take footpath opposite and to right, leading into Long Wood.
- **4**. At t- junction in woods, turn left and follow track through woods above river. Track eventually curves to right and uphill. Turn left along terrace path.
- **5**. After steep climb, turn left and follow path. Part way down hill, cross into field to right over stile and continue down along hedge line.
- **6**. At field exit turn left, signed 'Greenway

- Gardens ¾m'. Pass through gate and down track past houses. Turn left at road.
- 7. Continue along the lane and through gate. By Greenway Estate information panel turn right through gate. Once over brow of hill bear left down field edge path. At the bottom turn right along Greenway Drive.
- **8**. By the lodge house turn left down road to quay.
- **9**. To return to Kingswear. From here you can take a ferry to Dittisham and continue, following the Dart Valley Trail, back to Dartmouth. Alternatively you can take a ferry back to Dartmouth from Dittisham, or retrace your steps on this side of the estuary.




