by our onsite tenant Zenith Marine). Rigging provided by onsite tenant Lee Rogers Rigging. Finally, we have a well-stocked chandlery open 7 days a week during the summer period, 6 days during the winter. The full details of our services can be found in this 2022 Yearbook or drop into the Service Office where our staff will be more than happy to meet you and discuss your requirements.

All our staff are highly trained with many years of marine industry experience and are keen to provide all customers with an excellent, friendly service.

Being situated on the east bank of the lovely River Dart, not far from the entrance to the river, we enjoy the evening sunshine. 



MARINA FACILITIES



WI-FI - is available both on the main Marina and visitors' pontoon. Visitors can obtain the guest access code from the Berthing Office upon payment of the visiting fee. To access Wi-Fi select the Darthaven Club Wi-Fi hotspot. Extra time can be purchased through the portal. If you have any problems with this service please call Club Wi-Fi on 01626 270140.



Gas & Bottles - a range of Calor Gas and Camping Gaz refill exchanges and new cylinders can be purchased from the Berthing Office.



Launderette - situated at the back of our facilities block, with two industrial washing machines and tumble dryers. A sink and ironing board are also provided. Both the washers and dryers are coin operated and can be accessed from 08:30 - 22:00. (£4 per wash, 20p per five minute drying cycle).



Car Park - over 230 car parking spaces are available for use by berth holders, visitors and general public. The car park operates a Pay & Display system with a Number Plate Recognition system, run by Premier Parking Solutions (PPS). Annual or 6 month permits can be arranged directly with PPS - 0845 8621034 - NOT through Darthaven. There are 4 EV car charging units for electric cars.



Waste & Recycling - located opposite our Berthing and Service Office is the waste disposal area. We recycle as much waste product as possible and would greatly appreciate if, during your stay, you could do the same.

- Separated into two sections, general waste on the left and recycling on the right, it's never been
 easier. Please separate your glass waste.
- For the disposal of waste oil, please find the large green tank located under the railway bridge as
 marked on the Marina Map (page 9). For used fuel and oil filters please use the allocated bins to the
 right of the Engineering Workshop.



Pyrotechnic Disposal - in our Chandlery, we accept out of date flares only when purchasing replacements, so be sure to ask a member of our staff for more information. Otherwise, a licensed contractor must dispose of all waste flares. **FIRE HAZARD!** - **DO NOT DISPOSE OF FLARES IN THE RECYCLING BINS**



Security - CCTV operates 24 hours a day and monitored by our night staff on duty daily (7 days/week).

- Access to the Marina can only be gained by entrance through our electronic gates operated using an
 access code.
- Visitors should ask for the entrance code at the Berthing Office. This system is also in place in order to gain access to our facilities block and washroom areas.
- We operate a barrier entrance to the boatyard.

ON THE PONTOON

Darthaven Marina has 270 berths in total set over four main pontoons. We pride ourselves on keeping a clean and well- maintained environment throughout the year. **Water and electricity** outlets are available in every location and berth, along with well-lit walkways making for safe use during the evenings and at night. 16amp & 32amp electricity is available (32amp with selected berths only).

Berth holders are reminded to ensure their **mooring lines are suitable for winter storms etc** – if unable to get down to your boat or nervous about your boat's security over the winter, please give the Berthing Office a call and they will be happy to check on your behalf.

It's a good idea for berth holders to leave **boat keys** with the Berthing Office . . . just in case a problem arises in a boat owner's absence.



BERTHING & SERVICE OFFICES

At the top of the main bridge situated on the left is our **Berthing Office** – the Berthing Manager, Martin Pragnell and his team are located in the office to assist all visiting boats and berth holders.

Located on the right is our **Service Office** coordinated by Chris Bickle, Robin Coomer, Jo Wharton and Jess Kershaw. They are your first point of contact to organising works by any service department within Darthaven.

THE BERTHING OFFICE IS OPEN FROM 8.30AM TO 00.00 MIDNIGHT FROM MARCH TO OCTOBER AND 8.30AM TO 10.00PM FROM NOVEMBER TO FEBRUARY.

MARINA SAFETY

FOR YOUR SAFETY, DARTHAVEN MARINA EXPECTS...

- The wearing of lifejackets/buoyancy aids by all children under 14 years old when on the pontoons or aboard boats in the marina.
- Walk, don't run along the pontoons and do use the handrail on the access gangway.
- Cycles and scooters should only be ridden on the public road and not on the pontoons, the quay or any other part of the marina premises.
- For the benefit of all berth holders, dogs must be on a lead when on the quay, the pontoons, the car park indeed anywhere on the marina site. And do, please, ensure that no fouling occurs.
- Signs on the standpipes indicate that Darthaven Marina recommends that water be boiled before drinking when acquired through hoses.
- To avoid being a hazard to berth holders, trolleys should be returned to the area near the marina office after use. Do not overload them and no children in them at any time, please.
- No part of a boat, including its anchor, should overhang the walkways or pontoons.
- No items should be left on the pontoons or walkways at any time. This includes commercial fish boxes and diving bottles.
- If you have a fire on board, from your cockpit determine a sensible course of action . . . call the Fire service (999) . . . activate the fire alarm (by the Berthing Office) if practical. Maintain awareness if fire occurs anywhere in marina . .
- Take instructions from staff and/or emergency services.

BERTHING AND STORAGE

SUMMER BERTHING

During the Summer months, a small number of annual berth holders visit various parts of the UK or Channel Islands for extended periods of time. Due to this, berths of all sizes can become available between April and September. Contact a member of the Berthing Office staff for details.

WINTER BERTHING

Darthaven is the perfect safe and secure environment to winter your boat. Due to the Marina's position, we are very sheltered even during the worst of weather. Bring your boat in from a swinging mooring, anchorage or trot for convenient 24hr access and onsite parking.

Water is included and electricity charged at a unit rate. Winter berths are available from the 1st October to 31st March.

Stay afloat over winter (1st Oct – 31st Mar) on our sheltered and safe marina, subject to availability. £22 per metre + VAT, per month.

Due to high demand, we are unable to reserve berths in advance during the Summer months but will always do our utmost to accommodate vessels of all sizes up to 20m (65ft). Payment is due upon arrival.

Visiting yachts are requested to vacate the berth by 12:00 midday on the intended day of departure.



CASE STUDY - BOATYARD, ENGINEERS, ELECTRICIANS -ZENITH

Name of boat: Phaedrus - Make: VANCOUVER 32 • Beam 10' 6" - Draft 4' 10" - Displacement 6350kg

A little bit about the owner

Owner, Ben Bonnick has a wealth of solo sailing experience. Ben had previously sailed across from Antigua to the UK in 2012 as part of a crew and in 2015 bought his own boat, a Vancouver 27.

Ben then decided to take a sevenmonth sabbatical from work and achieve his dream of a solo Atlantic circuit (UK to West Indies via Canaries then West Indies back to UK via Azores). After returning back to the UK, Ben later made the journey over to Europe to pick up Phaedrus. On the return home to Brixham, there were unfortunately a number of problems with her engine resulting in her coming into Darthaven to have work done.

Phaedrus has had her own adventures in the past with four previous trans-Atlantic crossings to British Virgin Islands in 1990 and to St Lucia, Trinidad and Tobago in 2006.

The initial jobs were a repower replacing a Yanmar 3GM30 with a 3YM30 and the fitting of a Side Power SE80 bow thruster. Additional jobs were added once the boat was ashore, including re-fixing the toe-rails at the bow as there was too much movement in the fairleads. When lifted, we found there was quite a lot of damage along the bottom of the long keel - this was repaired by our Shipwright department Alongside the engine installation, the wiring and alternator charging system were upgraded, wiring tidied up, windlass connected to the bow thruster remote control and bilge pump issues resolved. Finally, fresh antifoul was applied prior to launch. She is now ready

for her next adventure with her new

owner



1. Our shipwrights started off by setting up and cutting out the holes to take the new bow thruster through.



2. The next stage was glassing in the tunnel with a high quality vinyl ester resin



4. After being lifted out it was very noticeable to our shipwrights that, over time, Phaedrus had sustained a fair bit of damage to the underside of her keel.



5. The underside of the keel was fully repaired and gelled to finish.

6. Phaedrus' work is now complete with her new wireless SidePower bow thruster installed.



7. After experiencing engine failure off the coast of Brixham. Phaedrus was repowered by replacing a Yanmar 3GM30 with a 3YM30 installed by our engineers.



8. Installation for the remote controlled wireless Side Power SE80 bow thruster and windlass. This was installed to ease the stress of single handedly docking when coming ashore.

CASE STUDY - YACHT REFINISHING - ZENITH

Name of boat: Baraka - Make: SWAN 53 • LOA 53ft - Beam 15.5ft

1.The entire hull was hand etched with P80 sandpaper and an underwater primer was applied in any necessary areas







4. SUPERSTRUCTURE POLISH

The gelcoat was acid washed, and areas protected. Then we machine rotary cut the gelcoat to remove any fading, oxidisation. Then we machine orbital polished with a high gloss polish to remove cut marks, holograms and swirls, leaving a perfect finish. We then hand applied a polymer wax to all areas. Brand new polishing pads are used on every boat.



2. ANTIFOUL APPLICATION

Two thick and even coats of Hempel tiger xtra Mille in black were applied.



to remove any old polishes, waxes and stains.
The antifoul was taped up to prevent dragging the paint into the polish and

to prevent dragging the paint into the polish and any other delicate areas were taped. We then rotary machine cut and polished

the hull. A polymer wax was then applied and buffed off leaving a high gloss, swirl and hologram free shine. Brand new polishing pads are used on every boat.



5. TEAK CLEAN

This is done by applying a part one acid clean to strip any dirt and loose fibres of the teak using teak friendly scrubbing pads by hand. Once rinsed thoroughly, a part 2 renovator is then applied using the same method and rinsed down.

6. WASH DOWN

After the polish was completed, we gave her a thorough wash down using our own branded economical soap. Detail brushes are used around fittings and hard to reach areas. A woollen wash mitt is used for the gelcoat and windows. The textured decks are pressure washed and using a melamine sponge we go over the windows to rid of any polish residue. The windows are bladed dry and the stainless is chammy'd dry.



7. BOW THRUSTER GEAR BOX SHAFT

We hand etched with P80 sandpaper and an underwater primer was applied in any necessary areas.

8. BOW THRUSTER GEAR BOX SHAFT

This was coated with three coats of Hempel Eco Prop in black.



The blades were removed, sanded, degreased.

10.BOW THRUSTER BOLTS -

This was greased and refitted along with new 16mm nyloc nuts and washers.

Two new zinc anodes were fitted on both port and star-board. Medium strength thread lock was used along with new Allen key bolts.

WASTE & SUSTAINABILITY

At Darthaven we are doing our best to limit our impact on the environment. 5 years ago we fitted 90 solar panels to the main office. Although not an ideal situation, they have produced 152 mwh of power. According to the supplier, this is the climate equivalent to planting 1,780 trees.

We linked up with Devon Contact Waste to remove our non-hazardous waste about 10 years ago. They now use all of the plastic waste they receive to produce garden seats/ tables on their site in Exeter. They are not the cheapest contractor but they are the greenest at the moment.

Hazardous waste is removed by Slicker Recycling to comply with regulations. We have purchased a shed positioned near the engineer's workshop to keep the waste undercover and to stop pollution entering the drainage system. Waste oil is collected in a holding tank. Oily rags, filters, etc are also collected. We also store and have removed both marine 12v & 24v batteries as well as everyday domestic batteries. Metal is stored and taken to Gormans for recycling.

5 years ago we fitted a FILTA BUND system to catch the pressure washing water used to clean the bottom of boats when they are lifted out. The system removes chemicals especially copper. The water then returns to the river cleaner than drinking water

The hoist uses vegetable hydraulic oil to operate in case of spillage.

Over the last few years, we have had a programme of replacing all of our lighting to LEDs. This is an on-going programme – we are over 80% of the way there.

Last year, when we changed our vans, we purchased an all electrical van for the electricians – we also have 1 fully electric fork lift.

5 years ago we fitted a black water pump on our visitor's pontoon facilities. This was and may still be the only one between Poole and Plymouth.

We are fitting new electrical cables and pontoon pedestals throughout the marina. These have LED's which will be controlled by an app, giving owners control over what power they use.

We stock a wide range of green products in our chandlery. These include non-chemical cleaning and polishing products. We have begun selling Torqeedo electric outboards as their main South West area engine sales dealer. Our service teams also use as many green products as possible. As part of our winterisation process we have now switched to using Safeguard marine antifreeze which is non-toxic and environmentally friendly.

Clean it All, our onsite cleaner contractors, also use green products. The cleanliness is tested on a regular basis.

Last but not least, we have just fitted 4 EV car charging units for electric cars. We are also fitting a covered bike store area in the car park to encourage berth holders, visitors and staff to cycle more often. We continue to monitor our 'green' credentials

and believe we have come a long way but we will continue to invest as appropriate.



Interview with Gary Jolliffe, Director of Till the Coast is Clear

TILL THE . COAST

Tell us a little bit about yourself and Till the Coast is Clear

I'm a family man based in Kingsbridge who has always held nature in high regard. I now spend my time trying to ensure that nature is well protected



and given the best opportunity to regenerate as possible. The social enterprise, Till the Coast is Clear, was set up in 2017 specifically to get hands-on with the increasing problem of plastic pollution on our coasts and estuary shorelines. We specialise in getting to less accessible locations using our boats and small fleet of kayaks and have recovered around 16 tonnes of plastic and other pollution off the South Devon Coast in the past 4 years.

How would you encourage berth holders to become more environmentally aware around the Marina?

As a boat owner, unless you operate a dugout canoe, or sail the Kon-Tiki, you have to accept that it is impossible not to have an impact on the environment. The manufacture alone of a typical GRP hull consumes a lot of energy and involves gallons of solvents and lots of plastic. Currently, there is no real viable use for end-of-life GRP hulls, which are typically land filled!

I visit quite a few marinas and to be honest, I always see plastic litter collecting around the base of vessels when being worked on shore. I am forever picking up cut off ends of rope, cable ties, eyelets from old tarps, the ends of silicone tubes and paint brushes. All these things eventually find their way into the sea, it is a quick win to tidy up as you go!

I am the first to admit that we also have an awfully long way to go. The project runs two boats made of recyclable plastic, both have 4 stroke outboards, trailers, metres of plastic rope and buoys onboard. We also tow them using a diesel van! We must do better and whilst our kayaks are made from recycled fishing nets and other post-consumer plastic waste and our paddles are wooden, we would like to transition to electric propulsion and possibly sail in the future.

Almost all mooring lines, halyards and buoy lines are made from plastic which degrades from abrasion and

UV over time e.g. you will see 'dust' coming off your lines after a dry spell, which is nano plastic taking to the air and sinking into the sea. It is these particles that have

and sinking into the sea. It is these particles that have entered the food ecosystem and are in much of the sea food we consume.

Your website states that your mission is to 'Inspire positive change and promote sustainable and regenerative practices towards a circular economic approach for the future'. Where does Darthaven Marine sit in context to this?

Having known the new managing director of Darthaven Marina, Sophie Bragg, for an awfully long time - we were at school together in Kingsbridge - it is clear to me that the business strongly recognises its responsibility to lead by example and to provide its customers with the best possible advice and opportunities to do the right thing.

I genuinely sense that this is due to a recognition that from here on in, all businesses will ever more strongly be measured by their stated aims, their commitment to their employees and the environment, rather than their profitability. This is important as there is already a detectable change in the behaviour of consumers who increasingly want to know more about the provenance of the products and services they buy into.

How can berth holders or the general public help make a difference with Till the Coast is clear?

We have a thriving volunteer programme and this underpins the work that we do. Increasingly, almost everyone I meet wants to contribute in some practical way, to help tackle the environmental and social issues we face and they often do not know where to start, just get stuck in is my advice, It is about getting hands on and taking responsibility.

We have a sponsorship model and are keen to align with organisations and businesses that are working hard to improve the way they operate. No one is perfect and it is better to help improve something than to turn your back in dismay which only perpetuates the issues. Around Dartmouth

Dartmouth Castle

Impossible to miss, Dartmouth Castle provides the focal point for many postcard shots of the Dart Estuary. Dating from 1488, it once protected the town from potential naval attack by a combination of a chain slung across the river mouth and a formidable collection of artillery. The castle and **St Petrox Church** are a must-see for anyone visiting the town. They can be accessed either by taking a short walk/drive from the Harbour Office or by the Castle ferry from Dartmouth Quay (opposite Rockfish). Also a Café with spectacular views across the Castle.


Britannia Royal Naval College

With an intriguing heritage spanning over 150 years, the BRNC is an essential place to visit for anyone with an interest in British history. Since 1863, Dartmouth and the River Dart have been the home of initial Naval Officer training in the UK – today, the BRNC is the only remaining Naval College in the country, fulfilling a vital role in training Naval cadets not only from Britain but those from the Commonwealth and all over the world.


Newcomen Engine House

The Engine House (adjacent to the Dartmouth Visitor Centre) is home to the only original Newcomen engine that can be shown working. The machine, built in 1725, was a giant step forward in the history of engineering and was a key step along the path to the Industrial Revolution – well worth a visit for any budding engineers! Along the coast

The Daymark, nr Kingswear

An 80ft octagonal limestone tower built in 1864 as a guide to mariners to the position of the harbour entrance. It is visible for many miles out to sea and is a true wonder of the South Devon coastline! Access via the South West Coastal Path from Froward Point, or park at Brownstone Car Park near Coleton Fishacre.

Blackpool Sands

An award-winning, privately managed 'Blue Flag' family beach with turquoise blue sea giving it an almost Mediterranean feel. Take a dip at this idyllic beach or enjoy organic Devon produce at the Venus Café. Dogs not allowed during the summer. Tel: 01803 770209 (Venus Café). Nr Stoke Fleming.

Hallsands

Discover the haunting remains of the lost village of Hallsands, between Beesands and Start Point. Once a thriving community, the village was washed away by storms in 1917 following the short-sighted removal of a nearby beach. Now only a few ruined houses mark this haunting site. Access via a narrow lane to the car park and a short walk.

Start Point Lighthouse

Sited at the end of the headland on one of the most exposed peninsulas of the English Coast,



the lighthouse has guided vessels in passage along the English Channel for over 150 years. With guided tours, it is open to the public throughout the year. Check website startpointdevon.co.uk for visitor information.Tel: 01803 771803

Slapton Sands

An extremely picturesque and popular dog-friendly beach, it plays an important part in the survival of some of the UK's rarest flora and fauna and is designated as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. It is also home to a Sherman Tank that was sunk in action during Exercise Tiger (preparation for the Normandy landings in WWII) and has now been recovered.

National Trust

Greenway was the beloved holiday home of the famous and much-loved author Agatha Christie and her family. Set on the banks of the Dart opposite Dittisham, the house contains many of the family's collections, including archaeology, Tunbridgeware, silver, botanical china and books and was the setting for the dramatisation of her murder mystery 'Dead Man's Folly', starring David Suchet.

It is located 3 miles from Darthaven, Visitors are transported back to the Jazz Age at the holiday home of the D'Oyly Carte family. In the 30 acre garden, it is easy to imagine the parties of the past amongst the weaving pathways and sheltered glades. This warm, secluded spot is perfect for tender plants from the Mediterranean, South Africa



and New Zealand. The elegant house is a place of 1920s' elegance. Music playing in the rooms echoes the family's Gilbert and Sullivan connections. Children will love the family activity packs.

There are some fantastic walks in this Area of Outstanding Beauty, some that start from the marina or just across the river in Dartmouth. The following information is provided by the South Devon AONB .

Make sure you wear sturdy footwear for both these walks.

Kingswear to Froward Point

Castles and cliffs, seals and skylarks, on a coastal circular walk rich in views, history and natural abundance.

Start: Darthaven Marina car park Distance: 5 miles (circular walk) Grade: Moderate to strenuous

Terrain: Coast path with some uneven sections

and long flights of steps; 2 steep

descents; 1 steep ascent.

Obstacles & Steep Gradients: 2 Stiles; 4 flights of steps; 2 steep descents; 1

steep ascent.

OS map: Explorer 0L20. Grid Ref: SX885512



Directions

- 1. From Darthaven Marina, turn right out of the car park along the road, then bear right again towards Lower Ferry.
- 2. At Kingswear Village Hall, turn left up Church Hill (The Ship Inn & St Thomas Church opposite). At top of hill, at hairpin bend, turn right along Castle Road (not Beacon Lane).
- **3**. After 0.5 mile, turn right down wooden steps, signposted Froward Point 1½ m.
- **4**. Just past Mill Bay Cove, turn right onto private drive, and then left after 30m, up steps and through woods. Pass above Newfoundland Cove to Brownstone Battery. (To explore the Battery, drop down the path to the right by



the Coastwatch station. Turn left by the first searchlight post, then left again following the 'acorn' waymarker. Fork left once more to wind back up to the Coastwatch lookout).

- **5**. Bear left onto the track signed 'HG Brownstone'. Past the Day Mark, fork left onto a green lane signed for Kingswear.
- **6**. Turn left at Brownstone and follow the footpath through the farm and past Crocker's Cottage crossing a small stream on large stones (taking care as, may be slippery). The footpath joins a private road. Bear left where the road forks, and then left again.
- **7**. Follow Castle Road to Church Hill. Turn left down Alma Steps. Retrace your steps past the steam railway, and fork left past the bus shelter to the car park.







Kingswear to Greenway

One of the area's truly great walks, this ramble follows the wooded banks of the broad and beautiful river Dart, on a route crammed with gems and jewels of human and natural history.

Start: Darthaven Marina Car Park

Distance: 4.5 miles Grade: Moderate


Terrain: Footpaths, fairly even, occasionally muddy through fields in wet weather; surfaced roads.

Obstacles & Steep Gradients: 5 stiles; 2 flights of steps; 2 steep climbs. This route is not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs.

OS map: Explorer 0L20. Grid Ref: SX 878515

Directions

- 1. From Darthaven Marina, by the railway level crossing follow yellow marked footpath alongside railway line. Head North with the river on your left.
- **2.** At the Higher Ferry slipway, turn right over the level crossing and up road. Just beyond public toilets, bear right up ramp and steps to climb through woods.
- **3**. At t- junction, turn left along drive, signed 'Greenway Ferry and Maypool'. Then at main road take footpath opposite and to left down steps and through woods. Take care crossing this road as ferry traffic turns at this sharp bend with limited visbility. At the tarmac drive take footpath opposite and to right, leading into Long Wood.
- **4**. At t- junction in woods, turn left and follow track through woods above river. Track eventually curves to right and uphill. Turn left along terrace path.
- **5**. After steep climb, turn left and follow path. Part way down hill, cross into field to right over stile and continue down along hedge line.
- **6**. At field exit turn left, signed 'Greenway



Gardens ¾m'. Pass through gate and down track past houses. Turn left at road.

- 7. Continue along the lane and through gate. By Greenway Estate information panel turn right through gate. Once over brow of hill bear left down field edge path. At the bottom turn right along Greenway Drive.
- **8**. By the lodge house turn left down road to quay.
- **9**. To return to Kingswear. From here you can take a ferry to Dittisham and continue, following the Dart Valley Trail, back to Dartmouth. Alternatively you can take a ferry back to Dartmouth from Dittisham, or retrace your steps on this side of the estuary.


